The **European Civic Forum** is a panEuropean network that brings together over 100 associations and NGOs across 28 European countries: a great variety of civic organisations ranging from big federations of associations deeply rooted in local constituencies, national platforms of NGOs uniting hundreds of thousands of NGOs across different sectors, human rights advocacy and campaigning organisations, or smaller groups working at community level or engaging with the public on local issues around the democratic values of **Equality**, **Solidarity** and **Inclusiveness**.

Civic Space Watch is an on line collaborative tool launched in 2018 by the European Civic Forum to monitor the state of civic space and civil liberties, alert media and policy makers and build solidarity and resilience inside civil society. Civic Space Watch aims to capture national and trans-European trends in real time, provide easy access to resources and facilitate systematic data collection for research, advocacy and campaigning purposes.

After a first successful edition in 2018, **#NODAYWITHOUTUS**, that engaged over 2 million people online, several thousand people offline and over 200 local committees in 29 European countries, the **Civic Pride Days** become an annual campaign coordinated by the European Civic Forum, mobilising civic actors all across Europe, in big cities or small communities, in their usual place of work or in public spaces, in large or small groups, online and offline, to collectively celebrate their daily contribution to our societies, improving the lives of our communities, promoting citizens' participation and access to human rights for all.
